



M4P Summer School Admissions Policy

Our aim is to offer access to all courses to as many students as we can accommodate, and places will be filled in order of receipt of applications.

To achieve this aim, we will:

1. Consult with tutors to establish caps on total numbers and specific instrument numbers for each course before the brochure goes online.
2. Specify in the brochure which courses are capped.
3. Accept and confirm applications in order of receipt
4. Once caps have been reached, let subsequent applicants know that the course is full, and invite them to change their application.
NB. If they are offering a minority instrument, we will check with the tutor if they wish to make an exception.
5. Mark the course as FULL on the website.
6. Once the total maximum number of students to the school has been reached, subsequent applicants will be informed that they are on a waiting list in case of cancellations.
7. The tutors will see a complete list of students on their courses for repertoire planning purposes, but will not be over-riding the first-come first served principle by choosing individual students in preference to others.
8. Acceptance of applications will be at the discretion of the Directors of M4P
